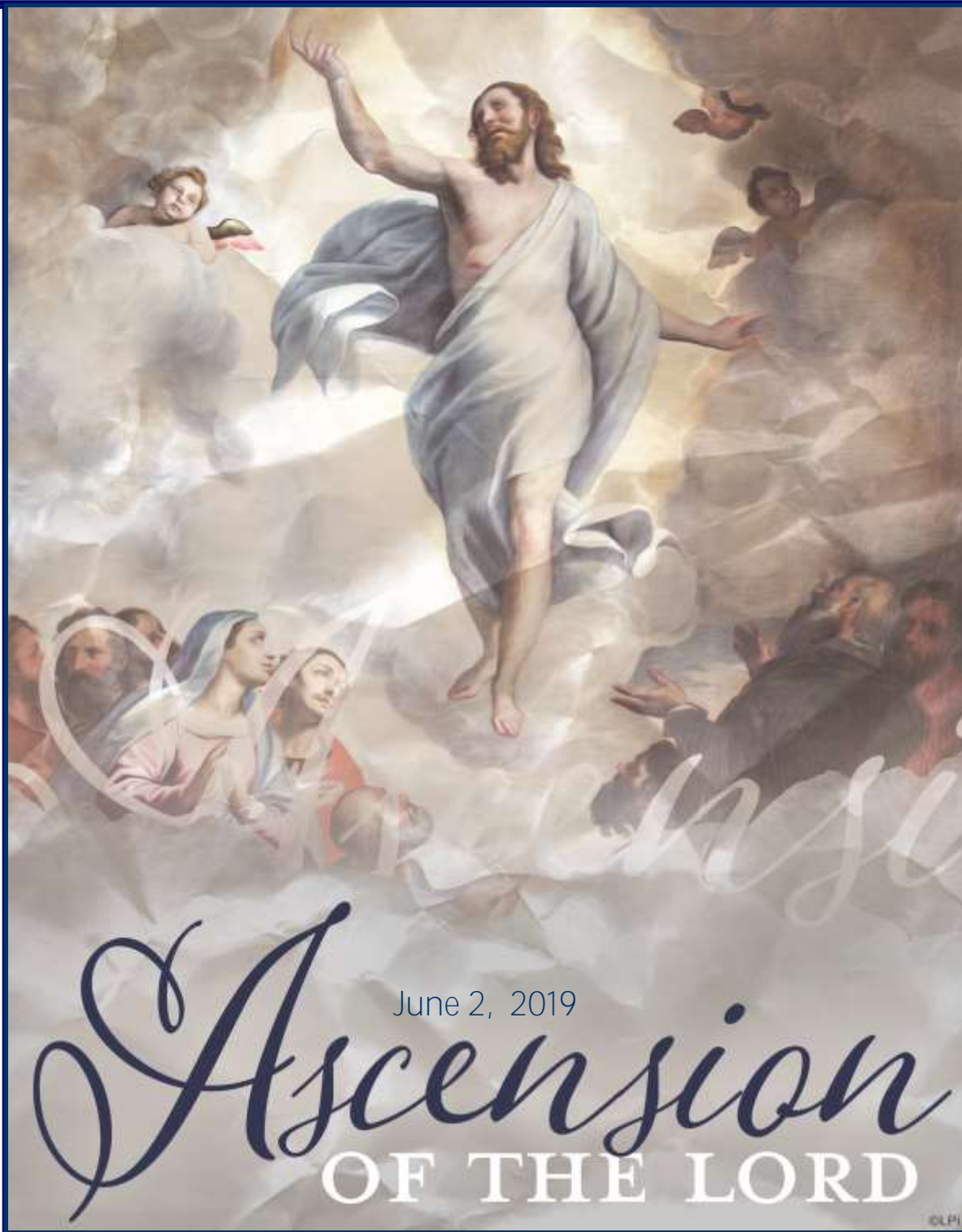

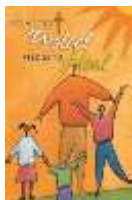

SUPREME COURT SANITY

In 2007, the US Supreme Court upheld the federal ban on “partial birth abortion,” a procedure in which a child is deliberately killed in the birth process. In that decision, *Gonzales vs. Carhart*, the majority opinion states, “Respect for human life finds an ultimate expression in the bond of love the mother has for her child...It is self-evident that a mother who comes to regret her choice to abort must struggle with grief more anguished and sorrow more profound when she learns, only after the event, what she once did not know: that she allowed a doctor to pierce the skull and vacuum the fast developing brain of her unborn child, a child assuming the human form.”

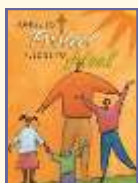

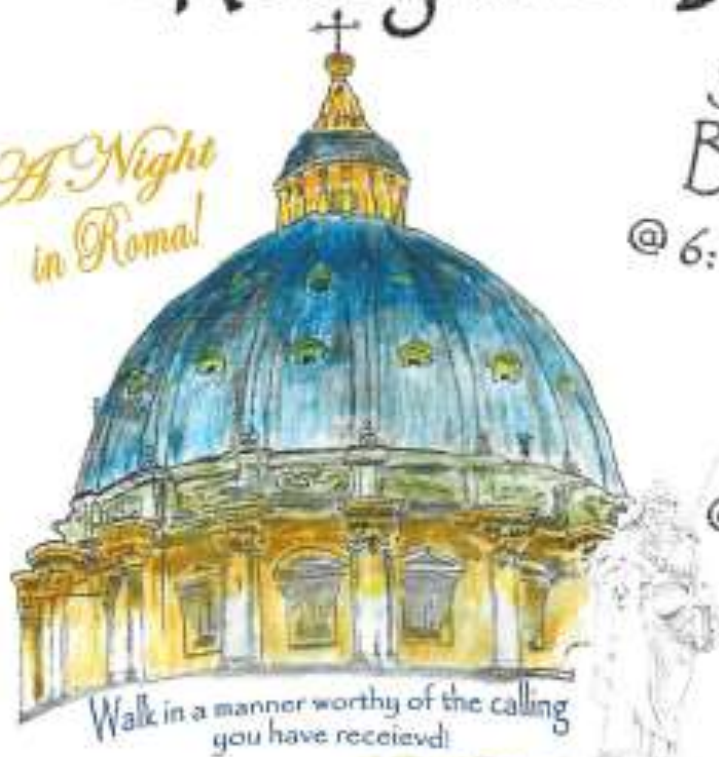
