- Ken gave a verbal update to go with the budget plan he submitted. He also said the diocese secured a payroll protection loan that will be forgiven that will ensure the payroll for the church and school staff. Mark asked Ken about purchasing new equipment to better stream the mass and other meetings around the parish. Ken said that as long as the amount was under \$5,000 that Fr. Brian had authority to approve purchases like this.

They have been holding ZOOM meetings with the high school aged kids. He said they are monitoring the status of the pandemic and are looking to start holding meetings outside. He also said they are looking to bring in more volunteers to diversify the gifts brought to the high school students.
